On May 9, 2018 at 11:00 a.m., sealed bids for four black 2018 police pursuit sedans or SUVs were opened at City Hall. Present for the opening were City Manager Lowell Crow, and Police Fleet Officer Lt Aaron Dykema.

There was 1 sealed bid received for police pursuit vehicles. The accepted bid was compared against the State bid of a 2018 Ford Interceptor sedan and SUV from Morrow Brothers located in Greenfield, IL.

The acceptable bid from Barkau Automotive in Stockton was a 2018 V-8 All-Wheel drive Dodge Charger.

- The bid was \$26, 175 per squad
- 3 squads for \$78,525
- Less the trade-in value of \$6400 bringing the total per squad to \$24,041
- Barkau was unable to provide a bid for an SUV, as Dodge no longer makes a pursuit rated SUV.
- **Delivery 17 weeks**

Morrow Brothers Ford (State Bid) was for a 2018 V-6 Police Interceptor sedan and SUV Utility

- \$25,326 for the All-Wheel drive Interceptor Sedan w/remote keyless entry, title and license included.
- \$28,936 for the All-Wheel Ford Interceptor SUV w/remote keyless entry, title and license included.
- Less the trade-in value of \$3000 bringing the total per squad \$24,326 per squad
- **Immediate delivery for the Ford Sedan**

Vehicles used for the trade-in quotes:

- 2011 Travel Squad (unmarked)
- 2011 Travel Squad (unmarked)
- 2011 current F9 (SRO car)

I would recommend acceptance of the Morrow Brothers Ford State Bid for the 2018 Police Interceptor Ford sedans for \$24,326 per squad (3) for a total cost of \$72,978.

Additional cost for either bid package includes:

- Wrapping 3 squads (In God We Trust) added \$4,200
- (3) Prisoner backseat inserts \$2,000
- (3) Partitions \$1,400

- (3) Squad change over w/new brackets (Mobile Electronics) \$4,000
- (3) Cell/WiFi antennas \$600
- (2) sets of window bars and freight charges \$900

Total cost of (3) fully equipped squads \$86,078

That would leave a balance of \$23,922 from the \$110,000 budgeted in Capital Equipment Fund Vehicles 31-02-742.

My recommendation would be to use this \$23,922 plus additional funds (\$15,379) from the capital fund Vehicles-Radios 31-02-741 to purchase and outfit a State Bid 2018 SUV base package squad for \$28,936 and equip it to replace the 2009 Ford Expedition K9 squad that we purchased used from Moline PD in 2015.

Up-fit costs would include:

- Installation at Buss Boyz (includes heat alarm, door popper, etc) \$3700
- K9 cage \$2000
- 10" fan \$315
- Rear air enabled \$800
- Center Console \$450
- VHF radio \$500
- Wrap \$1600
- Wi-Fi antenna \$200
- Modem \$800

Total cost of (1) fully equipped K9 squad \$39,301
