

Notice of Public Hearing - Public Transportation - City of Freeport

The City of Freeport is preparing an application for funding to provide public transportation within the City of Freeport and throughout the County of Stephenson, Illinois, through Section 5311 of the Federal Transit Act of 1964, as amended, and the Illinois Downstate Operating Assistance Program.

A public hearing will be held on Monday, March 20, 2017 at 6:00 p.m., during the regularly scheduled City Council meeting at the Freeport City Hall Building, 314 West Stephenson Street, Freeport, Illinois.

At the hearing, interested persons will have an opportunity to comment on the transportation project. Interested persons may submit comments in person at the public hearing or in writing to Alexander S.
