The last day to file objections to nomination papers of Established Political Parties is Monday, December 3, 2018, at 5:00 p.m. in the office of the City Clerk.

Candidates' nomination papers for Independent and New Political Parties will be accepted in the City Clerk's office at 314 W. Stephenson St., Suite 200, Freeport, Illinois, during customary City Hall business hours (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.) beginning Monday, December 10, 2018, through Monday, December 17, 2018.

The office of the City Clerk and all of City Hall is closed on weekends and will also be closed on Monday, December 24, 2018, and Tuesday, December 25, 2018.

The last day to file objections to nomination papers of Independent and New Political Parties is Wednesday, December 26, 2018, at 5:00 p.m. in the office of the City Clerk.
