

Freeport Police Department Vacation Home Check Program

The purpose of the Vacation Home Check is to provide a service to the citizens of Freeport by periodically checking their homes while they are away. This service helps to deter potential burglars and provides for additional security while the home is unoccupied.

The Freeport Police Department will utilize trained Community Service Volunteers to conduct the vacation home checks. In the absence of volunteers sworn officers will complete the home checks.

How to Apply

1. Vacation home check request forms are available at the Police Department thru the 911 Center and also on the city of Freeport's website. (www.cityoffreeport.org)
2. The vacation home check forms must be submitted in person, with valid I.D. to the 911 Center at the Police Department.

Homes not Eligible

1. Homes unoccupied and under construction
2. Homes unoccupied and listed for sale/show by realtors
3. Home located outside the city limits of Freeport.
